

Seasol Applications

FERTIGATION

For best results using Seasol via pivot or other spray irrigation systems:

- ✓ Apply Seasol throughout the irrigation run
- ✓ Use 20L to 50L Seasol for every mm of irrigation
- ✓ Target irrigations that are closest to critical development stages in the crop
- ✓ For irrigated pasture, apply Seasol in the first irrigation after grazing

- *Applying Seasol through the irrigation is both easy and convenient*
- *Seasol is Filtered to <150 microns so it never blocks nozzles*
- *Proven effective in Potatoes and Irrigated Pasture*



When applying Seasol via irrigation, the target is to achieve dose rates over the foliage and to the expected soil depth the irrigation will reach within the range of 1-in-200 to 1-in-500 dilutions.

Seasol via Irrigation

Seasol is easy to apply through any spray irrigation system in the same way as (and often in combination with) liquid feed nutrients.

For best results, it is important to achieve the proper dose rate – bearing in mind that irrigation wets both the foliage and a certain depth of soil.

Application rates have been calculated to achieve this with any irrigation – based on the mm of water being applied per hectare.

Use this method for the most reliable results:

- 1. Apply Seasol throughout the irrigation run** to ensure a consistent dose from the top of the canopy to the target depth in the soil.
- 2. Use 20L to 50L Seasol for every mm of irrigation.** To produce concentrations from 1-in-500 to 1-in-200.
- 3. Target irrigations that are closest to critical stages in crop development** for maximum growth stimulus. Seasol is also useful when watering during hot spells to reduce plant stress.
- 4. For irrigated pasture, apply Seasol in the first irrigation after grazing** to ensure rapid growth & high palatability.
